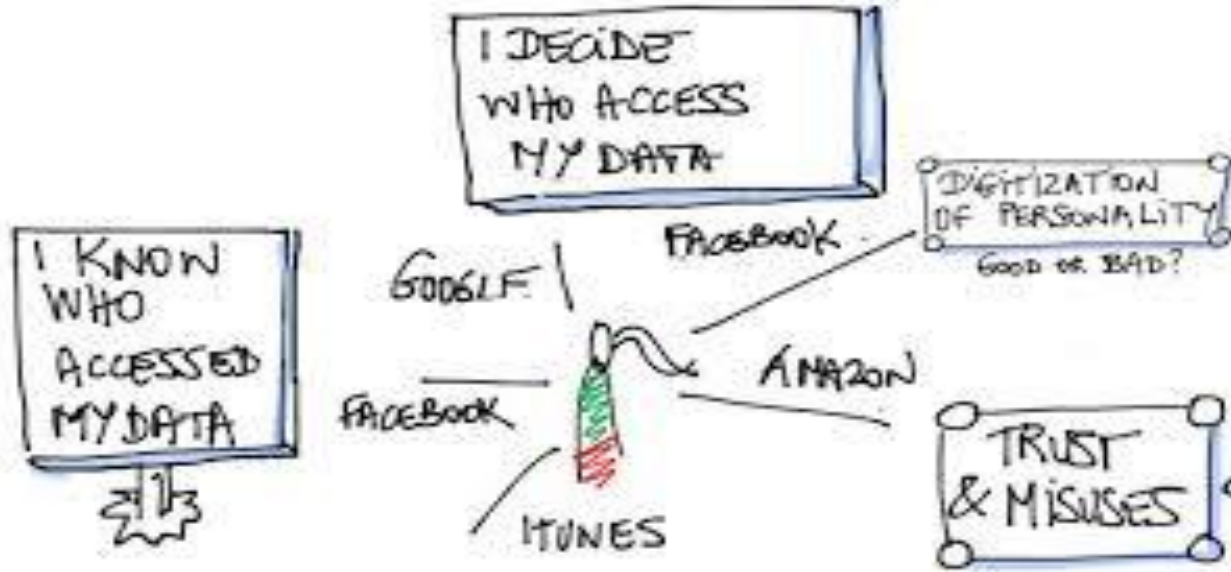


Data protection for natural

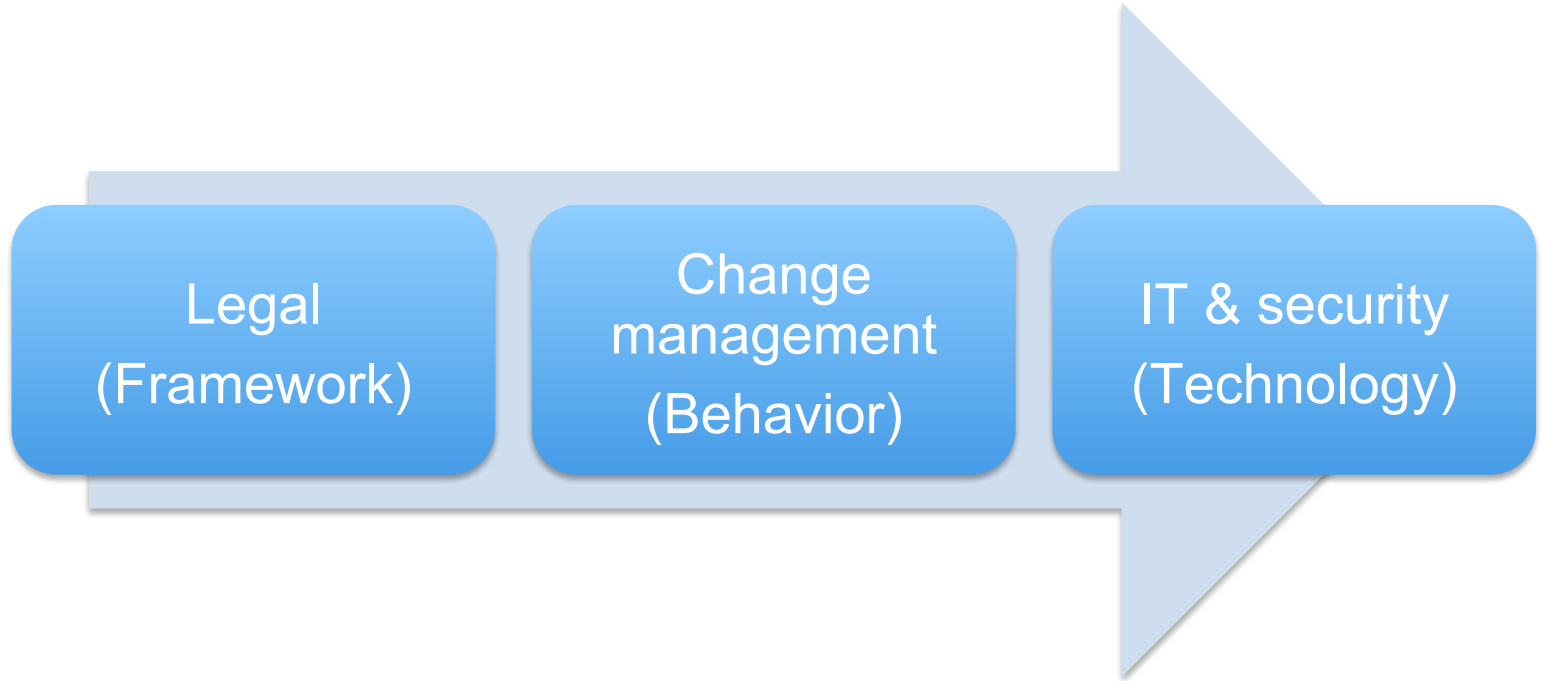

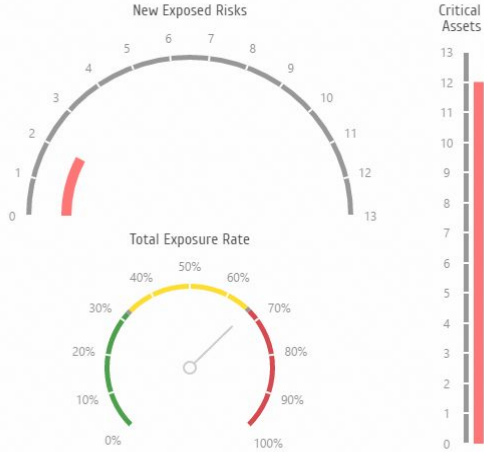

Attack Path Scenarios



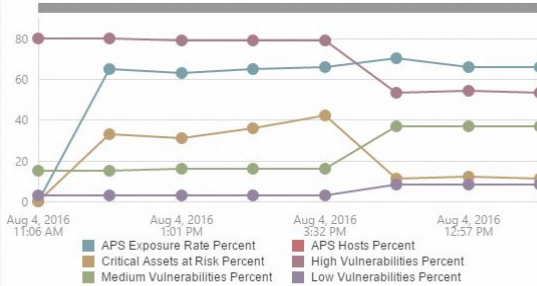

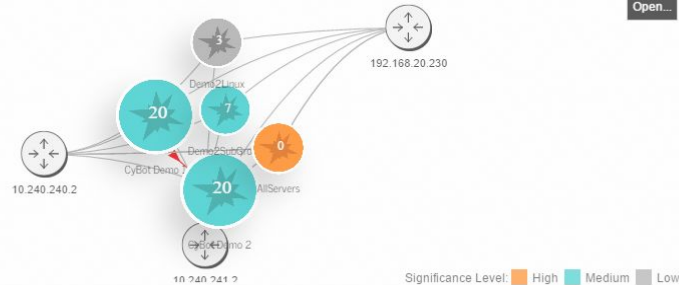

Network Risk Trends



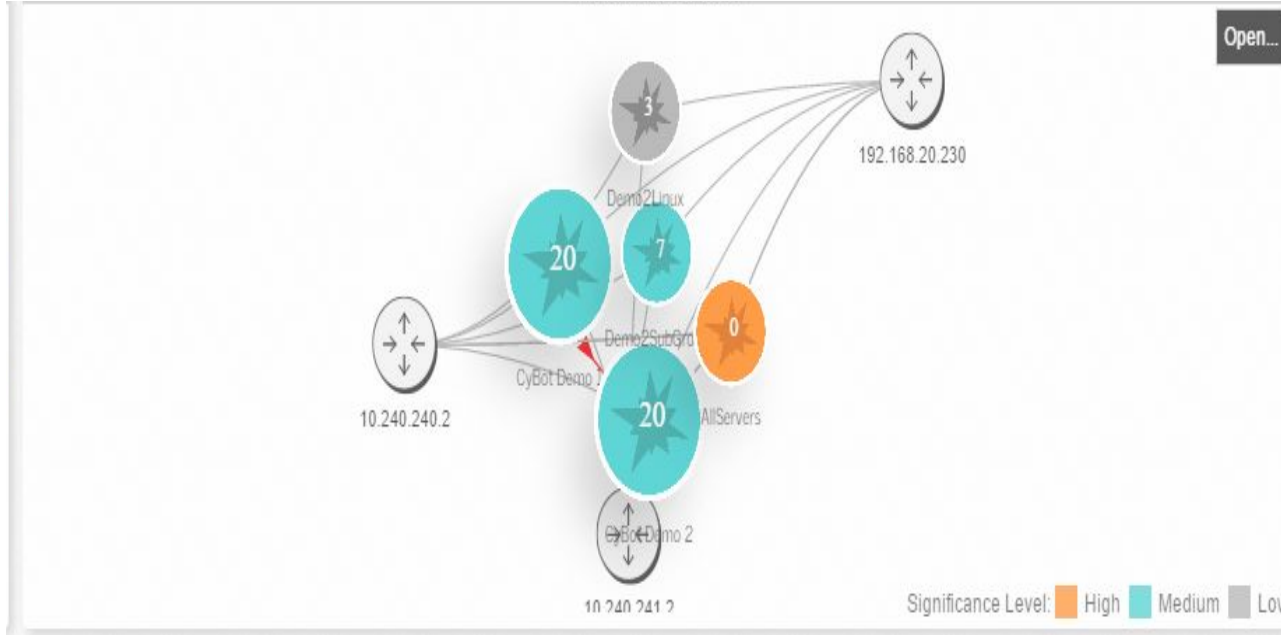
Network Status Map
